Moreover, the article could benefit from a more comprehensive review of the literature on anti-trust laws in Indonesia's manufacturing sector and their effectiveness in promoting fair competition. In terms of organization, the article could benefit from a clearer structure and more concise language. Additionally, the article would benefit from a more critical analysis of the limitations and potential biases in the data and sources used with a more comprehensive and critical analysis of the topic.

- 2. The literature review presented provides a comprehensive overview of the concept of anti-trust laws and their impact on industrial development. The review highlights the importance of anti-trust laws in promoting competition, preventing the formation of monopolies, and prohibiting any illegal practices such as price fixing and collusion. - B. Overall, the article is informative and well-written, providing valuable insights into the relationship between anti-trust laws and industrial development in Indonesia. However, further empirical evidence and detailed recommendations could have strengthened the argument.
- C. The authors may emphasize in discussing the Indonesian government's focus on the policies that must be implemented to ensure assistance from the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and develop a strategy to promote structural reforms.
- D. Authors must refer to the agreement signed between the Indonesian and German governments in August 1998, which was effective in supporting the drafting procedure and implementation of the Anti-monopoly law in Indonesia. The operational support was provided by a German Technical Assistance Agency known as Gesellschaft fuer Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ).
- E. Additionally, the authors must highlight how support from other international organizations such as the World Bank, Ausaid, CISA, and USAID effectively provided technical and financial resources for the Indonesian government to ensure the establishment and implementation of an effective Antimonopoly law in the country.
- F. The article concludes with recommendations for the KPPU to be provided with more authority and resources to ensure the implementation of anti-monopoly law in the manufacturing sector in Indonesia to promote fair competition between the firms resulting in the economic and industrial development of the country.
